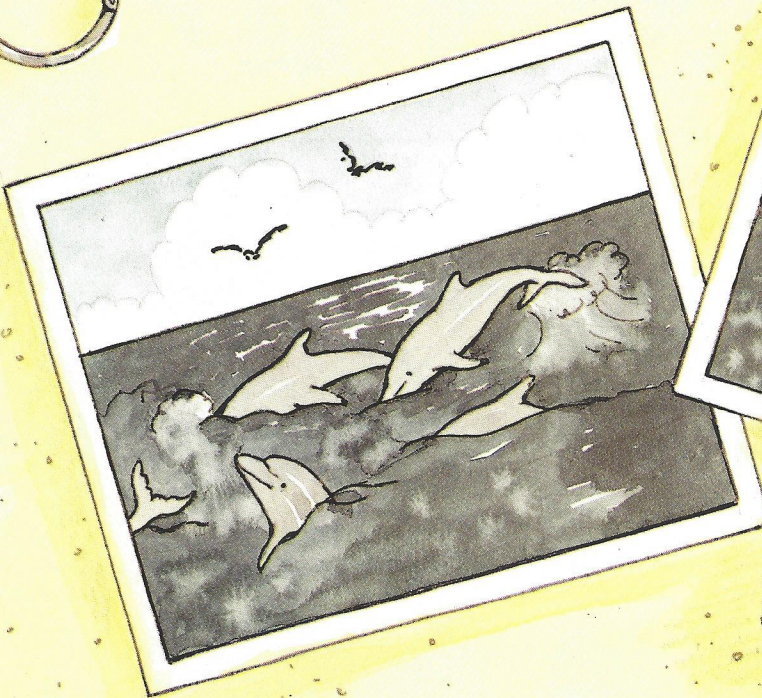
We bought tickets to the aquarium. We saw penguins and fish. But we missed the dolphin show. We all felt sad.







The next day, we drove north. We stopped at a pretty beach. We ate lunch there. After lunch, we got a wonderful surprise.

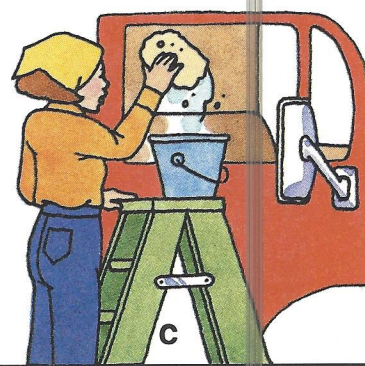
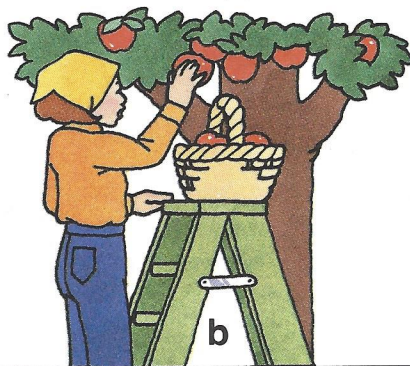
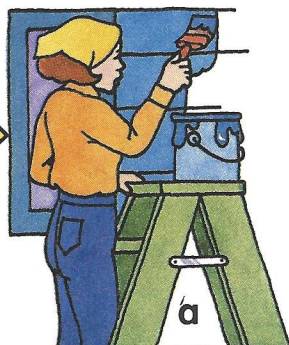

It glistened like a huge snowball in space.



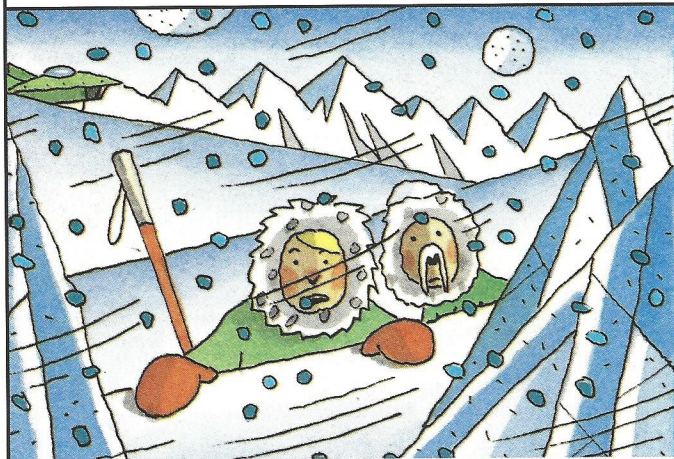
Tip and Top dressed in their arctic suits.

They followed the footprints to a big hill of snow.



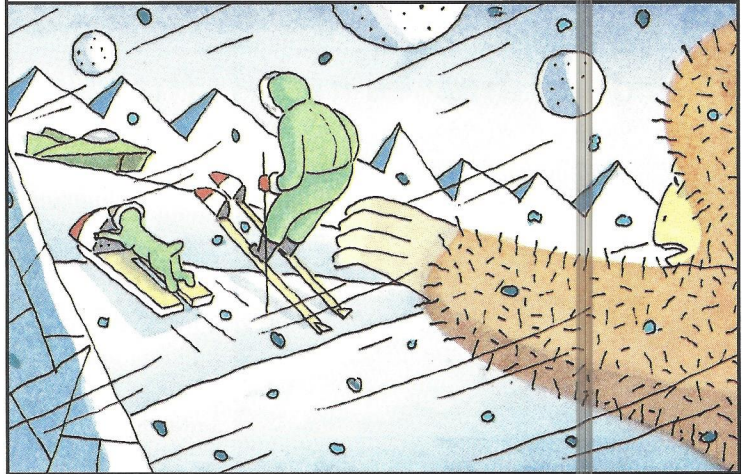

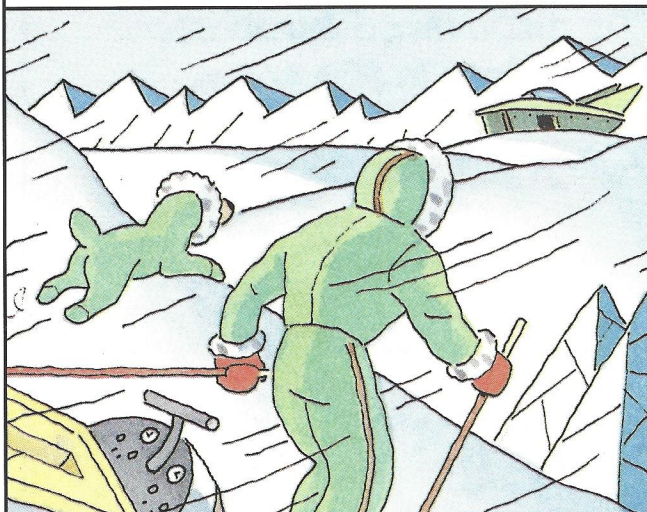

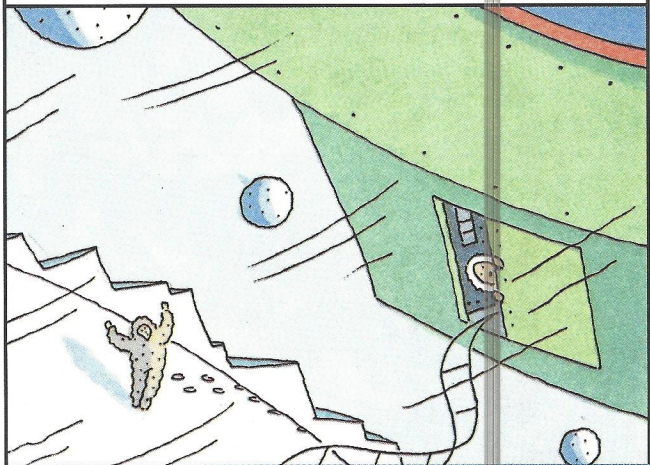

Then he thought about his friend Little Donkey.





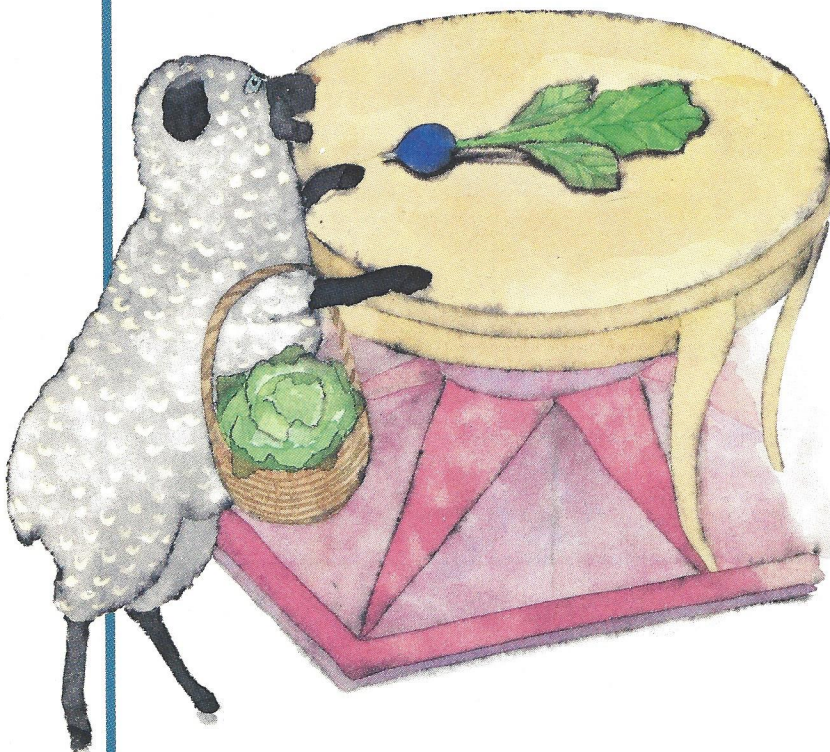

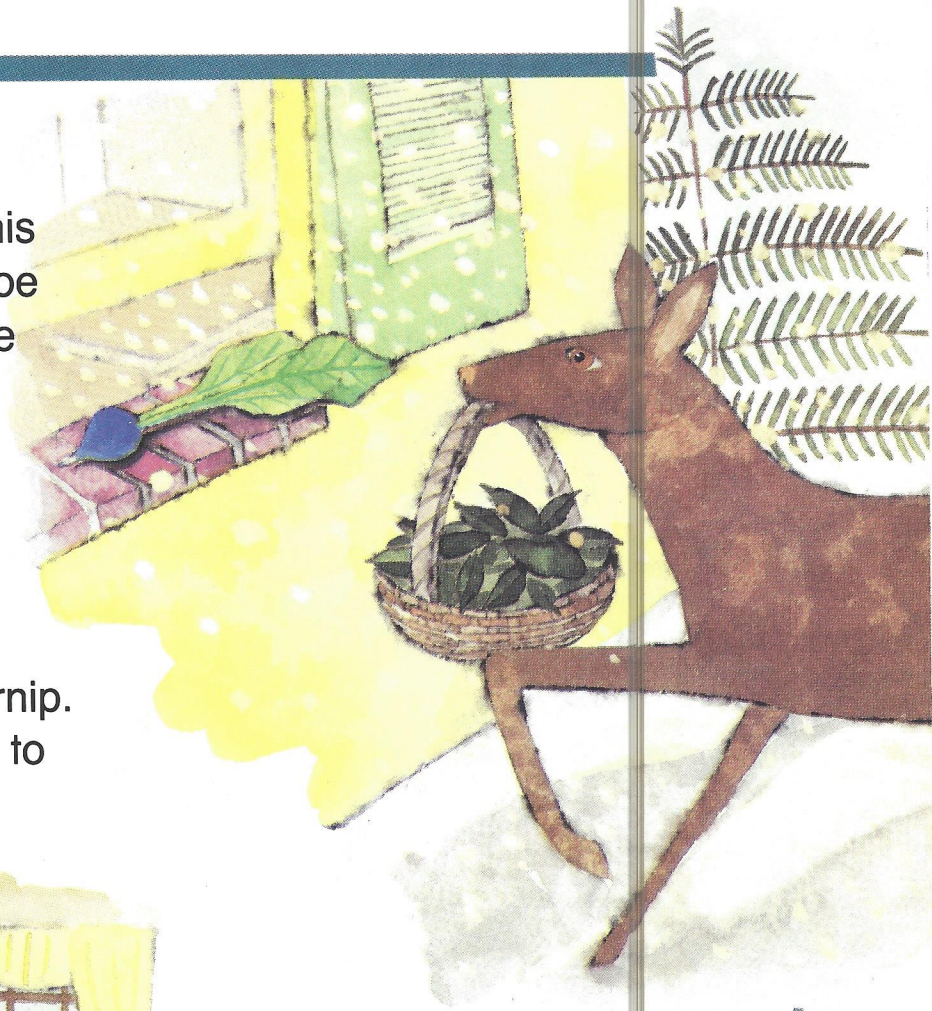

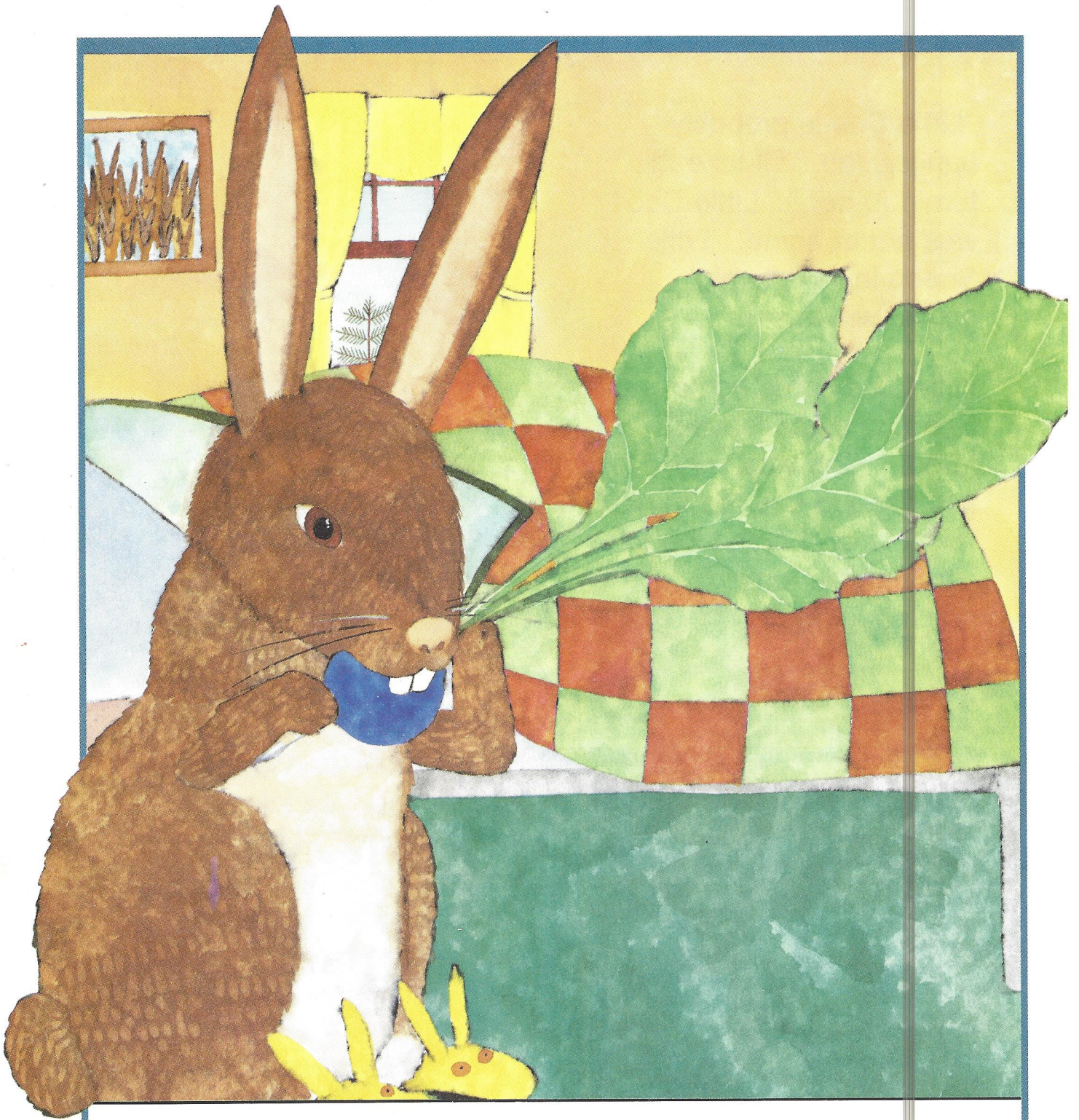
