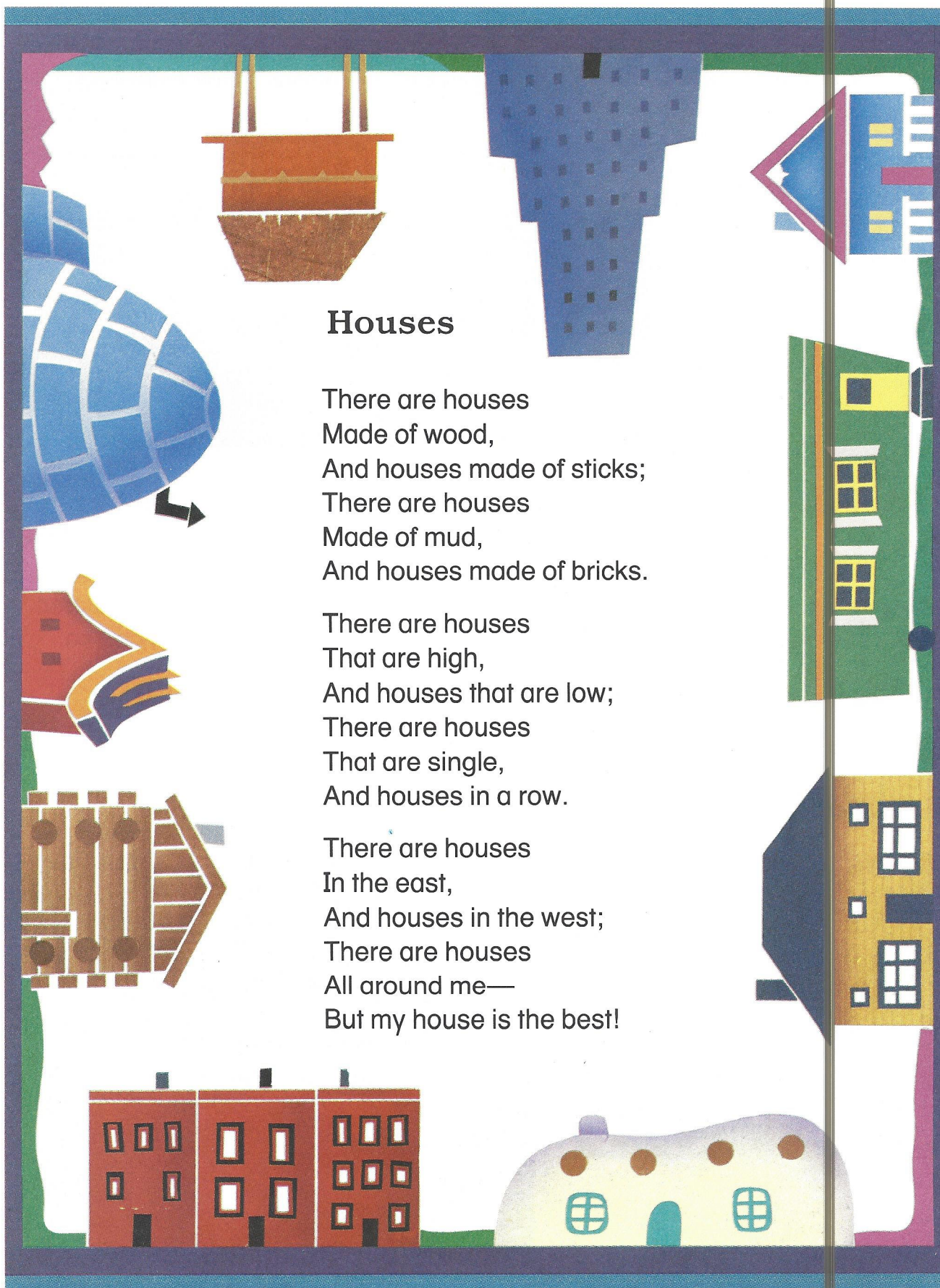


People make their living in different ways. Some people grow food. Some people raise animals. Some people work in offices and factories. Some people sell things in stores. How do people in your community make their living?

And houses in a row.

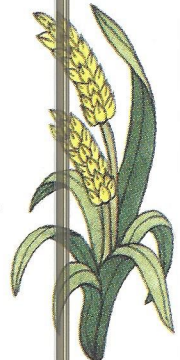

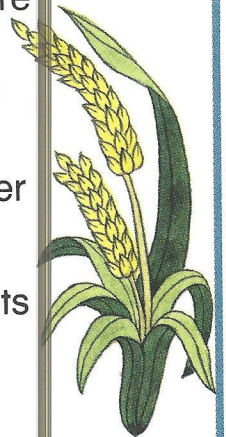


One day, Liu was in the village. Some farmers were talking about their rice.

Liu hurried home. He measured his rice. The plants were strong and healthy. But they were only two inches high.

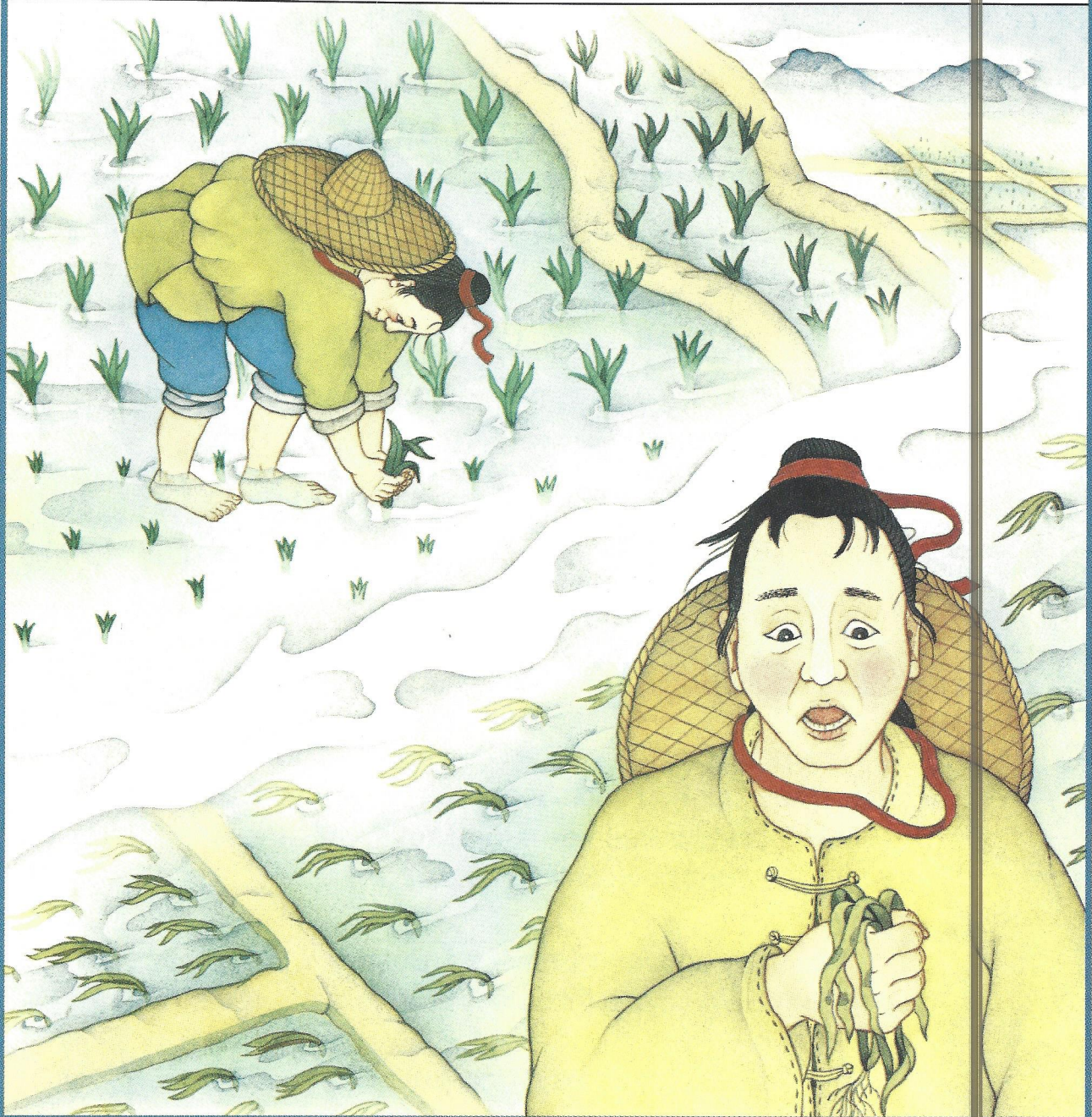
